CHANGE: ENHANCEMENTS TO CHAIN OF CUSTODY FORM (CCF)

- Impact: Added the following to the CCF for each completed collection:
 - o DER company information
 - o Donor and collector signatures
 - o Donor ID verification type (ID, Employee Rep)
 - MRO information
- Purpose: Aligns with industry standards for CCF documentation in drug testing.

CHANGE: RESULT PUSH API


- Impact: Added ability for Hound Labs to push results via integration. Specifications will be available within Hound Labs' existing digital asset.
- Purpose: Resolves VOC request from Concentra.



CHANGE: COLLECTION STATUS UPDATE IN USER INTERFACE (I.E., COLLECTED)

- Impact: New columns for Sample Outcome and Event Status will be visible on both the bulk results table and the individual result detail page in Retriever.
- Purpose: Aligns with industry-standard descriptions of the drug testing lifecycle.

Example: Individual Result Detail Page






CHANGE: LOCATIONS TAB IN UI USER VIEWS

- Impact: Addition of a 'Locations' tab in the main organization view top header.
- Purpose: Allows users to view their Locations in a single table view.

CHANGE: ADDED FIELDS FOR DONOR PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS

- Impact: Individual donor detail result page.
- Purpose: Readies the system for capturing donor contact details on the Base Station in the coming months (will eventually be used on the CCF and to trigger donor CCF delivery).

CHANGE: LAB COMMENTS VISIBLE ON RESULTS PDF

- Impact: Laboratory comments will appear in the Lab Results section of individual results details and printed PDFs.
- Purpose: Displays laboratory comments related to the sample in alignment with drug testing industry standard practices.

CHANGE: ADDED DATABASE SECURITY ROLLOUT TO DEV AND QA ENVIRONMENTS

- Impact: Behind the scenes for Development and QA environments; no impact to production or customer-facing environments.
- Purpose: Required prerequisite for security enhancements on production environment in coming months; will also allow for multi-factor authentication function.

CHANGE: FIXED USER LIMIT FOR CUSTOMERS WITH 10+ USERS

- Impact: Behind the scenes for production environment.
- **Purpose:** Resolves issues with user limitation of 10 and user availability on the base station (identified from customer experience).
